Family Life Catechesis

nurtures faith within the family, helping parents and children grow in their relationship with Christ and live out Catholic values through teaching, prayer, and daily life.

Children's Liturgy of the Word

is a special worship experience where young children hear and reflect on Scripture in an ageappropriate way, helping them understand and engage with God's Word during Mass.

Youth Ministry

is the parish's pastoral effort to engage, evangelize, and nurture the faith of young people, helping them grow in their relationship with Christ, the Church, and others through prayer, service, and community.

Young Adult Ministry

is a faith-based community that supports spiritual growth, fellowship, and service, helping young adults integrate their faith into their personal and professional lives.

Adult Faith Formation/Catechesis

is the parish's process of nurturing and deepening the faith of adults through ongoing catechesis and study, helping them grow in discipleship and live out their faith in daily life.

Order of Christian Iniation of Adults

OCIA guides and supports adults in their journey to the Catholic faith through catechesis, prayer, and sacramental preparation, leading to their full initiation into the Church.

Genesis Mission

is a method of accompaniment that fosters a deeper sense of discipleship and a greater desire to connect and evangelize while confidently sharing the Gospel message.

Vocations Ministry

is the parish's effort to foster a culture of discernment, prayer, and support, helping individuals recognize and respond to God's call to priesthood, religious life, marriage, or dedicated single life.

Catholic Women's Club

fosters community and spiritual growth among women through social events, service projects, and prayer, while supporting the needs of parishes and promoting Catholic values.

Ministry of Lector

is a sacred role in which a person proclaims the Word of God during the Liturgy, helping to inspire faith and deepen the assembly's understanding of Scripture.

Extraordinary Ministry of Holy Communion

is a group of laypeople entrusted with assisting the priest in distributing the Body and Blood of Christ during Mass and bringing Communion to the sick or homebound, ensuring the reverence and accessibility of the Eucharist.

Ministry of Usher

involves welcoming and assisting parishioners during Mass, helping with seating, collection, and maintaining a reverent atmosphere, all while fostering a spirit of hospitality and service.

Ministry of Acolyte (Altar Server)

involves assisting the priest during Mass and other liturgical services by performing tasks such as holding the liturgical items, preparing the altar, and supporting the sacred rituals, all in service to the liturgy.

Ministry of Music

involves leading and supporting the congregation in prayer through song, enhancing the worship experience with liturgical music that fosters spiritual reflection and unity in the celebration of the Mass.

Hospitality Ministry

involves welcoming and engaging parishioners and visitors with warmth and kindness, fostering a sense of belonging and community, and helping to create an inviting atmosphere for worship and fellowship.

Livestream Ministry

involves broadcasting Masses, liturgies, and other parish events online, enabling those unable to attend in person to participate in worship and stay connected with the parish community.

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament Society

is a group dedicated to offering prayer and worship before the Eucharist, fostering a deeper devotion to the presence of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament through silent adoration and reflection.

Community Building & Outreach

fosters a welcoming, inclusive environment by organizing events, supporting parishioners in need, and promoting social justice, all aimed at strengthening the parish community and extending outreach to those beyond the parish.

Bereavement Ministry

provides spiritual and emotional support to individuals and families grieving the loss of a loved one, offering comfort through prayer, companionship, and practical assistance during the funeral preparation process.

Prayer Warriors

involves a group of individuals dedicated to intercessory prayer, offering spiritual support for the needs of the parish, community, and the world, and strengthening the parish's prayer life through constant prayer.

Visits to the Sick & Homebound

brings the Eucharist to those unable to attend Mass (especially residents of assisted living facilities), ensuring they remain connected to the Church and nourished by the Body and Blood of Christ.

Parish Men's Club

engage men in service-oriented activities that support the parish community, promote fellowship, and encourage spiritual growth through participation in outreach, events, and volunteer opportunities.

Christ Child Society

serves those in need, particularly children and families, by providing material assistance, spiritual support, and acts of charity, all while promoting the values of Christian service and compassion.

Altar & Rosary Society

assists in the care and maintenance of the church's sacred liturgical items, such as altar linens and vessels, and to support the parish through acts of service, prayer, and fundraising.

Parish Bazaar Committee

to organize and coordinate fundraising events, such as bazaars and festivals, to strengthen parish community engagement, raise funds for parish needs, and promote fellowship among parishioners.
